Greetings.

In continuation of the first circular sent by Prof. S.P. Vyas ,Secretary, Rajasthan History Congress, I take the privilege of inviting you to participate in the 34th Session of the Rajasthan History Congress to be held on 19th - 20th December, 2019 (Thursday and Friday) at Department of History,IASE (Deemed to be University), Sardarshahr. The City of *Sardarshahr* eagerly awaits your arrival in its unique historical-cultural ambience.

About the IASE Deemed to be University:

The Institute of Advanced Studies (IASE) was sponsored by Gandhi Vidya Mandir as its parent organization. The Government of India accorded it the formal recognition of Deemed to be University, under Section 3 of the UGC Act-1956 vide notification F.9-29/2000-U.3 of 25th June 2002, and by the UGC vide notification F.6-25/2001 (CPP-I) of 17th July 2002, the deemed to be university is now working under a no profit company; “Institute of Advanced Studies in Education of GVM foundation” under section 8 of the company act with corporate identity number: U80904RJ2018NPL0663228 dated 17.12.18.The University is nestled like an oasis in the Thar desert, near the town of Sardarshahr in India’s north-western state of Rajasthan.

The IASE (Deemed to be University) boasts of resident/non-resident students, from UG to Ph.D. level having three faculties namely Faculty of Education, Faculty of Engineering & Technology and Faculty of Humanities & Social Sciences. There are well- planned hostels for about 1000 students, separate for boys and girls, amidst a self-contained colony of academicians. The sprawling 100 acres deemed to be university campus is a verdant oasis in the lap of an intense desert. It is dotted by large parks, gardens, playgrounds, auditoria, cultural and spiritual centre. The parental society Gandhi Vidya Mandir was founded by late Swami Ramsharanji Maharaj way back in 1950. The foundation stone of the Rural University was laid down by the first president of India Dr. Rajendra Prasad in 1955.

About Sardarshahr:

Sardarshahr is located in the Thar Desert in Churu district in the North western part of the Rajasthan state. A tiny village named Rajiawas, in the erstwhile state of Bikaner, was picked up by His Highness Sir Ratan Singh to develop into a city after the name of his loving son Sardar Singh in 1838. The area was perhaps ruled by the Mohils of that time. A statue of Indrapal Mohil at the town side is a testimony to the fact. It is known for its grand havelis with beautiful frescoes work. Its white marble clock tower is remarkable for its unique architecture. The town is also famous for its architecture and wall painting. The town also has some religious places like Ram manch, Ichchhapurna Balaji Temple, Samadhi Sthal- (Shanti Peeth) of Acharya Shri Mahapragya. It is the birthplace of Eleventh Acharya(Religious head)- Acharyashri Mahashramanji of Shri Jain Terapanthi Sect. It is also known for its handicraft work, silver work and wood works.

Theme:

Norms for Papers

- It is essential that all the copies of papers should bear the full names of the author/s, their e-mail ID, mobile No. and address (both office and residence) at the top of the first page.
- Members are requested to submit their papers to the undersigned by 05th Dec., 2019. The paper received later will not be included for presentation.
- Each paper should be sent in two copies, which should be word-processed, 1.5 spaced, footnotes to be similarly spaced and put at the end, and an e-mail, with the hard copy, should be provided. The total length should not exceed 10 pages of main text(A/4 size) and 2 pages of footnotes.
- Abstract: Maximum 250 words , Full Paper words limit 2500-3000 . Font: English – Times New Roman, Size 12 & Hindi – Kurtidev, Size 12 . Line spacing -1.5. Footnotes should be numbered continuously for the whole paper (not per page).
- Should be used if maps, diagrams, and photographs are furnished, to be ready for printing (in JPG format). Two hard copies of the abstract & full length paper.
