The degree course (B.Ed.) was started in 1956, M.Ed. in 1960 and the facility for Ph.D. in Education was added in 1968. In 1993, BTTC was upgraded to the status of the Institute of Advanced Studies in Education (IASE), under the centrally sponsored scheme of restructuring and reorganization of Teacher Education. IASE was converted in CTE from 20th February, 2008. This is one of India's premier institutes in the teacher education sector pertaining to teacher training right from primary upto the doctoral stage.

The university is nestled like an oasis in the Thar Desert, near the town of Sardarshahr in India's north-western state of Rajasthan. The 'Institute of Advanced Studies in Education', one of the premier Institutes in the country today, came into being under the Government of India's Scheme of Education in 1993. It was formally declared as 'Deemed to be University' by the Government of India under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 vide notification F.9- 29/2000-U.3 of 25th June 2002, and UGC notification F.6-25/2001 (CPP-I) of 17th July 2002. Its educational facilities include a multi-faculty college for girls and co-education colleges in education, Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Faculty of Humanities and Social sciences, Ayurveda college including panchkarm, yoga and other related departments.. There

are separate hostels for boys and girls, accommodating 1,000 students. AC rooms are also available on demand. The IASE deemed University, a NAAC accredited institute with 'B' grade, is the core constituent of GVM, entrusted with the higher education portfolio, providing requisite autonomy and support.
