University RESEARCH POLICY

PREAMBLE:

The IASE Deemed University has a policy to encourage research conducted by faculty members, students and other scholars. Research based teaching in various disciplines of study is extremely important as it enhances the quality of the teaching-learning processes. Thus for promoting the research culture amongst the faculty members as well as students, a research policy has been formulated by the University. The objectives of the research policy are as given below.

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH POLICY:

The research policy of the University is:

1. To inculcate a sense of devotion to truth and knowledge by getting individuals to research work for good of all without temptation of money and fame
2. To create individuals who are able to provide proof of knowledge by their conduct rather than only data, logic and experiments
3. To identify current challenges in identifying "human problems" and solving them
4. To promote integrated thinking and inter & multi-disciplinary research culture
5. To draft an outline of a Universal Curriculum for Peace & Harmony, Human Values and Education
6. To bring out literature/books/Study Material/ Journal/Research Articles on various topics related to Education, Human Values, Peace & Harmony
7. To develop Political, Social, Economic harmony Theories through harmony research
8. To create a network of Peace & harmony Researchers & Academicians
9. To encourage faculty and students to carry out research
10. To organize seminar, conference and workshops to identify thrust areas for research and promote and support others
11. To provide guidance to students and faculty for preparing research proposals
12. To publish research papers in leading national and international journals.

POLICY DETAILS:

[A] The following are the ingredients of the Research Policy of the University.

A Research and Recognition is established at the University level. University will established three Research Committees named University Research Board (URB), Faculty Research (FRB), Departmental Research Committees (DRCs).

[B] Procedure for approving Research Proposals:

1. Faculty members/students/Academician who wants to undertake research studies will prepare a research proposal and forward it to the DRC and FRB as per the requirements. The proposal will include the title of the proposal, preamble, need for the study, objectives, research methodology including hypotheses and data collection methods and expected time frame for completion of the proposal. The proposal will also include a budget for expenditure that will be required to complete the proposal.
2. The proposal will be screened by the departmental and Faculty level committees and if they find it satisfactory, the committee will recommend it for approval to the Research and Recognition Committee (URB). The URB will consider the proposal and also the recommendations of the departmental committee and accordingly give its sanction for the proposal.
3. The Director – Research shall monitor the progress of the proposal as well as the publication of the research paper/project reports, etc.
4. The concerned faculty member/student will have to give a six monthly progress report stating clearly the progress made in the research study.
5. The University may establish University Research Chairs for spliced researches for interdisciplinary research as per the norms approved by the Board of management.
6. The University may collaborate, sponsor and support the research in the area of Peace, harmony, Human values and Education, because these are the thrust areas of the institution/university.
7. As far as possible, faculty members will be encouraged to conduct the research proposals during the vacation. In case they are required to go for data collection during the academic session, a duty leave application shall have to be given to the Head of the Department. Duty leave not more than 3 days at a time and total 30 days in a year will have to be approved by the Vice Chancellor.
8. University will strictly follow the byelaws (RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO Ph.D. DEGREE)

[D] . MEGA RESEARCH PROJECTS

The university will formulate a hypothesis based on the vision and mission of its parent organization or identify a problem of global significance. A leader will be identified for each project and will work on a strategy, time frame and methodology to verify/provide solutions to the same. These projects can be funded from external sources but funder will not decide the topic, content or methodology of work nor hold any rights over the material developed through the project. All material developed should be used for good of all mankind and be kept open source as much as possible. The formulation, budget and other details will be decided on a case by case basis with inputs from parent organization. Thrust should be on innovative approach and authority can be widely decentralised if desired to faceplate the same. URB along with Chancellor and a representative of the parent organisation shall consider and take decision on these projects.
